



And being found in appearance as a man, he humbled himself by becoming obedient to death - even death on a cross!"





10 "Whoever would love life and see good days must keep his tongue from evil and his lips from deceitful speech. He must turn from evil and do good; he must seek peace and pursue it."





1 Peter 4:12-15

12 "Dear Friends, do not be surprised at the painful trial that you are suffering, as though something strange were happening to you. 13 But rejoice that you participate in the sufferings of Christ, so that you may be overjoyed when his glory is revealed. 14 If you are insulted because of the name of Christ, you are blessed, for the Spirit of glory and of God rests on you. 15 If you suffer, it should not be as murderer, or a thief or any other kind of criminal or as a meddler. However, if you suffer as a Christian, do not be ashamed, but Praise God that you bear that name.



15 "But do this with gentleness and respect, keeping a clear conscience, so that those who speak maliciously against your good behaviour in Christ may be ashamed of their slander."







