James means here that there is no time in life that God does not invite us to himself. Calvin



Do I have to pray out loud?

This passage is less about the <u>how</u> but much more about the <u>Who</u> with.

Pray needs to happen in community.
Is anyone among you ill? Let them call the elders of the church to pray over them and anoit them with oil in the name of the Lord. 5:14



Why do we struggle with this? Praying for healing.

It's hard to share how we really are. What happens if I am not healed?

Confessing our Sin

Unspoken sin holds power, confessed sin unlocks forgiveness.

Accountable relationships help us walk away from sinful habits.
