The Jife of God 1. comes from the altar

Ezekiel 47:1

The man brought me back to the entrance to the temple, and I saw water coming out from under the threshold of the temple towards the east (for the temple faced east). The water was coming down from under the south side of the temple, south of the altar.

The Tife of God 2. flows out!

Ezekiel 47:2 He then brought me out through the north gate and led me round the outside to the outer gate facing east, and the water was trickling from the south side.

The Tife of God 5. brings abundant life

John 10:10 The thief comes only to steal and kill and destroy; I have come that they may have life, and have it to the full.





The Tife of God 6. needs LOADS of fisherman

Ezekiel 47:10 Fishermen will stand along the shore; from En Gedi to En Eglaim there will be places for spreading nets. The fish will be of many kinds – like the fish of the Mediterranean Sea.





The Tife of God 6. needs LOADS of fisherman

Matthew 4:19 'Come, follow me,' Jesus said, 'and I will send you out to fish for people.'





The Tife of God 7. needs the sanctuary

Ezekiel 47:12

Fruit trees of all kinds will grow on both banks of the river. Their leaves will not wither, nor will their fruit fail. Every month they will bear fruit, because the water from the sanctuary flows to them. Their fruit will serve for food and their leaves for healing.'





Do you see this?
