






Luke 10:1


After this the Lord appointed seventy-two others and sent them two by two ahead of him to every town and place where he was about to go.

"It will be fun!" they said


Luke 10:3

Luke 10:4


Do not take a purse or bag or sandals; and do not greet anyone on the road.

Luke 10:5-7





Luke 10:8-8

'When you enter a town and are welcomed, eat what is offered to you. Heal those there who are ill and tell them, "The kingdom of God has come near to you."





Stay, eat, pray, speak



The Kingdom is near

Acts 3:6

Then Peter said, 'Silver or gold I do not have, but what I do have I give you. In the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth, walk.'







1. Pray first

John 5:8-9

Then Jesus said to him, 'Get up! Pick up your mat and walk.' At once the man was cured; he picked up his mat and walked.









2. Pray there and then!

John 5:8-9

Some of them were looking for a reason to accuse Jesus, so they watched him closely to see if he would heal him on the Sabbath. Jesus said to the man with the shrivelled hand, ... 'Stretch out your hand.' He stretched it out, and his hand was completely restored









3. Pray short and simple

Matthew 6:7

And when you pray, do not keep on babbling like pagans, for they think they will be heard because of their many words.









4. Proclaim the Kingdom of God

Luke 11:20

But if I drive out demons by the finger of God, then the kingdom of God has come upon you.









4. Proclaim the Kingdom of God

Matthew 11:4-5

Jesus replied, 'Go back and report to John what you hear and see: the blind receive sight, the lame walk, those who have leprosy are cleansed, the deaf hear, the dead are raised, and the good news is proclaimed to the poor.
