2. The authorities stole the body

**Acts 4:2** 

They were greatly disturbed because the apostles were teaching the people, proclaiming in Jesus the resurrection of the dead.





#### 4. Jesus didn't actually die

#### Mark 15:43-44

Joseph of Arimathea, a prominent member of the Council, who was himself waiting for the kingdom of God, went boldly to Pilate and asked for Jesus' body. Pilate was surprised to hear that he was already dead. Summoning the centurion, he asked him if Jesus had already died.





4. Jesus didn't actually die

John 19:32-33

The soldiers therefore came and broke the legs of the first man who had been crucified with Jesus, and then those of the other. But when they came to Jesus and found that he was already dead, they did not break his legs.





4. Jesus didn't actually die

John 19:34

Instead, one of the soldiers pierced Jesus' side with a spear, bringing a sudden flow of blood and water.





### 5. Appearances were hallucinations

#### 1 Corithians 15:5-7

## THE TRUTH

The resurrection of Jesus Christ is a factual reality

**Romans 10:9** 

If you declare with your mouth, 'Jesus is Lord,' and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved.
