So WHY do we feel like this?





Where do these rotten roots come from? 1. WOUNDS: the sins of others that hold us captive Isaiah 61:1 The Spirit of the Sovereign Lord is on me, ... He has sent me to bind up the brokenhearted, to proclaim freedom for the captives and release from darkness for the prisoners



Where do these rotten roots come from? 2. BONDAGES: our own sins that keep us prisoners Isaiah 61:1 The Spirit of the Sovereign Lord is on me, ... He has sent me to bind up the brokenhearted, to proclaim freedom for the captives and release from darkness for the prisoners



1. A sense of unworthiness

Luke 15:19 I am no longer worthy to be called your son; make me like one of your hired servants."



2. Perfectionism

Philippians 3:4-6 I have more: circumcised on the eighth day, of the people of Israel, of the tribe of Benjamin, a Hebrew of Hebrews; in regard to the law, a Pharisee; as for zeal, persecuting the church; as for righteousness based on the law, faultless.



3. Super-sensitivity

1 Samuel 20:30 Saul's anger flared up at Jonathan and he said to him, 'You son of a perverse and rebellious woman! Don't I know that you have sided with the son of Jesse to your own shame and to the shame of the mother who bore you?



4. Fear

Fear and trembling have beset me; horror has overwhelmed me. **Psalm 55:5**



The Holy Spirit knows what we need

He will guide us into all truth

John 16:13 But when he, the Spirit of truth, comes, he will guide you into all the truth. He will not speak on his own; he will speak only what he hears, and he will tell you what is yet to come.



The Holy Spirit knows what we need

We need to invite him

Romans 8:26-27

In the same way, the Spirit helps us in our weakness. We do not know what we ought to pray for, but the Spirit himself intercedes for us through wordless groans. And he who searches our hearts knows the mind of the Spirit, because the Spirit intercedes for God's people in accordance with the will of God.



A simple model 1. Invite the Holy Spirit to lead you

Psalm 139:23-24 Search me, O God, and know my heart; test me and know my anxious thoughts. See if there is any offensive way in me, and lead me in the way everlasting.



A simple model 2. Ask what the root is

Psalm 51:6 Surely you desire truth in the inner parts; you teach me wisdom in the inmost place.



A simple model 3. invite Jesus to heal the wounds

Psalm 18:16 He reached down from on high and took hold of me; he drew me out of deep waters.



A simple model 4. Confess any wrong ATTITUDES and ACTIONS and ask God to forgive and cleanse

1 John 1:9 If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just and will forgive us our sins and purify us from all unrighteousness.
